RULES.

- 1. All Dogs run must be the bona fide property of the Competitor. Dogs entered for the Open or Champion Competition can can be worked by the owner or his servant. Protests for infringements of this Rule must be lodged with the Club's Secretary, in writing, within 24 hours from the date of the Trials, accompanied by a deposit of 10s, which will be refunded if the protest is sustained but may be forfeited if protest be rejected. If protest be sustained the prize will be awarded to the next dog. Any Competitor disqualified for infringing this rule shall pay 10s to the Club. Protests shall be decided by the Committee, whose decision shall be final and binding on all parties.
- 2. Each dog to be held in leash. Any dog interfering with another while working will be disqualified by the Judges.
- 3. Competitors must be ready when called, or they may be disqualified by the Judges.
- 4. All Competitors must accept the Course and work laid out for them by the Committee.
- 5. The Judges will be at liberty to stop a dog at any point of his trial.
- 6. The Judge's decision will be final and not subject to review by any Court of Law.

GENERAL REGULATIONS.

- I. Any dog that lays hold of a sheep in any way whatever will be immediately called up and be disqualified, and the owner of such dog will be liable for any damage done.
- 2. Any Competitor disobeying the Judges or any of the Authorities will be disqualified.
- 3. No dogs, except those competing, will be allowed on the ground, and any person bringing a bitch in heat will be immediately turned off the ground and disqualified from competing.
 - 4. The decision of the Judges shall on all points be final.
- 5. If the entries exceed the number that the Committee consider can be run in one day, the Committee will draw by lot the dogs to be excluded in any Stakes, but every possible effort and arrangement will be made to run all dogs entered.
- 6 No person will be allowed with the dog competing except the man working it, and he will be placed where the Judges direct.
- 7. The Judges will decide as to the time the dogs will be allotted to do the work set out, and have a power of ordering up as soon as he pleases any dog that commits a flagrant error.
- 8. The Committee reserve the power to withdraw or alter any prize.
