

NETHYBRIDGE SHEEP DOG ASSOCIATION TRIALS

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1 .- Any dog that lays hold of a sheep in any way whatever will be immediately called up and be disqualified, and the owner of such dog will be liable for any damage done.

2.—Any competitor disobeying the Judge or any of the Authorities will be

disqualified

3.—No dogs except those competing will be allowed on the ground, and any person bringing a bitch in heat will be immediately turned off the ground, and disqualified from competing.

4.—The decision of the Judge shall on all points be final.

5.—All sheep dogs entered must have been not less than three mouths the bona fide property of the exhibitor, and, except when competing, must be held by a cord or chain, under penalty of disqualification.

6.- The names of the sheep dogs will be balloted, and the dogs will be run

in the order drawn, or at the discretion of the Committee.

7.- Not more than two dogs will be run by any one competitor

- 8.—Dogs must be run in order shown on programme unless otherwise called upon.
 - 9.—Any dog not present when called upon may be disqualified 10 .- The Judge has the power of ordering up .. y dog he pleases.

11.- Entries most be accompanied with fees.

12. - Entrance fees for dogs not drawn, or rejected before the Trials, will be returned.

13.—The Committee reserve the power to withdraw or alter any prize.

14.—All protests must be lodged on the day of the Trials in writing



Note: - In addition to Prize Money, the following Trophies have been presented: -

The "Glendyne Trophy" (Open).—A handsome Silver Bowl presented by Lord Glendyne
as a Perpetual Trophy, for the competitor with dog or bitch scoring highest points.

The "Beckingham Challenge Cup" (Confined).—A handsome Silver Cup presented by Mrs C. W. Beckingham for the competitor with dog or bitch scoring highest points. Confined to the Counties of Inverness, Moray, Nairn, to dogs and bitches not already prize-winners in any Open Competition. (Must be won three times in succession, or any four times.)

"The Seafield Challenge Cup" (Open).—Presented by the Countess of Seafield. To be won by the Competitor scoring highest points. Open to all bona fide Hired Flock Shepherds. (Must
